Sequoia Living was proactive in establishing a COVID-19 action plan in March and we will continue to do whatever we can to keep everyone as safe as possible and continue to deliver on our mission of healthy aging.

Our Financial Health

While COVID-19 tests our mental and physical health, Sequoia Living's Board of Directors and leadership team have been proactively identifying ways to retain our financial health and mitigate the impact of COVID-19.

- Our Marketing staff is reaching out to prospective residents on our wait lists to ensure people stay informed and engaged.
 - Once the Shelter in Place (SIP) order is lifted, we look forward to safely welcoming new neighbors and guests into our health centers and our independent living apartments.
 - We expect that move-ins will resume in June or July and will do so at a slower pace than we previously enjoyed.
- Each area of Sequoia Living is deferring non-essential expenses.
- Capital expenditures are being adjusted.

These efforts will strengthen our ability to weather these economic shocks.
